 country skiing, playing tennis and reading.

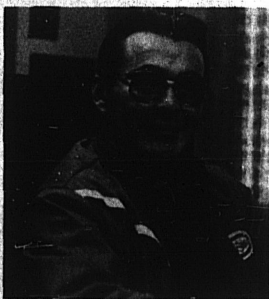
