

Picture contest announced

The Alaska Federation of Natives (AFN) and its health career department is sponsoring a Bush Art Contest for Native Alaskan children, ages 6-13.

Its purpose is twofold: to collect and exhibit the art work of Alaska's rural children and to use the outstanding pictures in recruitment materials. The AFN hopes to heighten children's awareness of a health career through their own perceptions and imaginations.

The deadline date for submission is May 11th. All contestants may submit work to the Alaska Federation of Natives in Anchorage. No art work will be returned, however all finalists and winners will

receive certificates of merit or prizes of up to \$1,000 in cash or merchandise.

All art work must be done on white drawing paper size 12 x 18. Any medium except pencil or pen may be used (ie, poster paint, magic marker, pastel or crayon).

The subject matter must pertain to health or health careers. Pictures should include title, name, address, and schoolteacher's name.
