Our Governor, Congressional Delegation and The Alaska State Legislature urge you to

Not everyone "outside" opposes Alaska's self determination. Many people would help us resolve D2. But someone they know has to ask them.

Next week Congress will reconvene to vote for or against an Alaskan Lands Bill. They have three options: the Interior Committee Bill (Huckaby); the Merchant Marine Committee Bill (Breaux); or a new bill just introduced by Congressman Morris Udall.

Alaska's Consensus position supports the Huckaby and Breaux Bills, rather than the Udall Bill. The latter is too restrictive to be a balanced bill and it does not adequately address the State's Seven Consensus Points.

These are the points which most Alaskans want to see included in any D2 Bill:

- 1) Revoke the Antiquities Act
- 2) Convey our State Lands
- 3) Exclude Known Resources from Federal Enclaves
- 4) Provide Adequate Access to State and Private Lands
- 5) Continue Traditional Alaskan Land Uses
- 6) Let Alaska Manage Our Own Fish & Game
- 7) Make No More Federal Land Withdrawals in Alaska

You can help get Congress to pass an acceptable Alaskan Lands Bill!

All of us have friends and relatives living "outside." Each of them has a Congressman. And nothing affects how a Congressman votes more than a letter, a phone call or a telegram from a Constituent.

Alaska is outnumbered 434 to 1 in the U.S. House of Representatives. But the total number of our friends and relatives outside" can multiply our voice immeasurably. Our team in Washington has made real progress, but now is the critical

time. They need your help.
