

New president elected for Dartmouth medical students

Henry Brown, a Yupik Eskimo, son of Mr. and Mrs. Anthony Bean of Mountain Village, Alaska, was recently elected president of the Student National Medical Association, Dartmouth college chapter.

Henry is also a recipient of a National Health Service Corps (NHSC) Scholarship for the 1978-79 school year. The scholarship pays tuition, fees, other reasonable educational expenses and a \$429 monthly stipend for living expenses. For each year of support though, a recipient

is obligated, upon completion of training, to serve a year in the NHSC in a manpower shortage area.

Henry has participated in the AFN Health Career Trainee Program as an intern at the Bethel Health Clinic and at the Fort Yukon Native Health Clinic.

In this year's planned traineeship, Henry has submitted a proposal to study the possible relationship between infant nutrition and the incidence of middle ear infection in Yupik Eskimo children.
