

WORKSHOP ANNOUNCEMENT

JANUARY 4-8 MICRO-COMPUTERS FOR RURAL BUSINESSES
(Co-sponsored by Tanana Valley Community College)

This five-day workshop will be an intensive, hands-on introduction to the use of the Apple II micro-computer for small businesses in rural areas. Emphasis will be on word processing, spreadsheets, accounting and data base management systems. Following the workshop, there will be an on-going audio conference course to provide reinforcement of the skills learned for participants once they return to village.

COST: \$500 per participant (discount for more than one from a single organization or business).

FEBRUARY 3-5 INVESTMENT DECISION-MAKING AND CASH MANAGEMENT
