PUBLIC MEETING

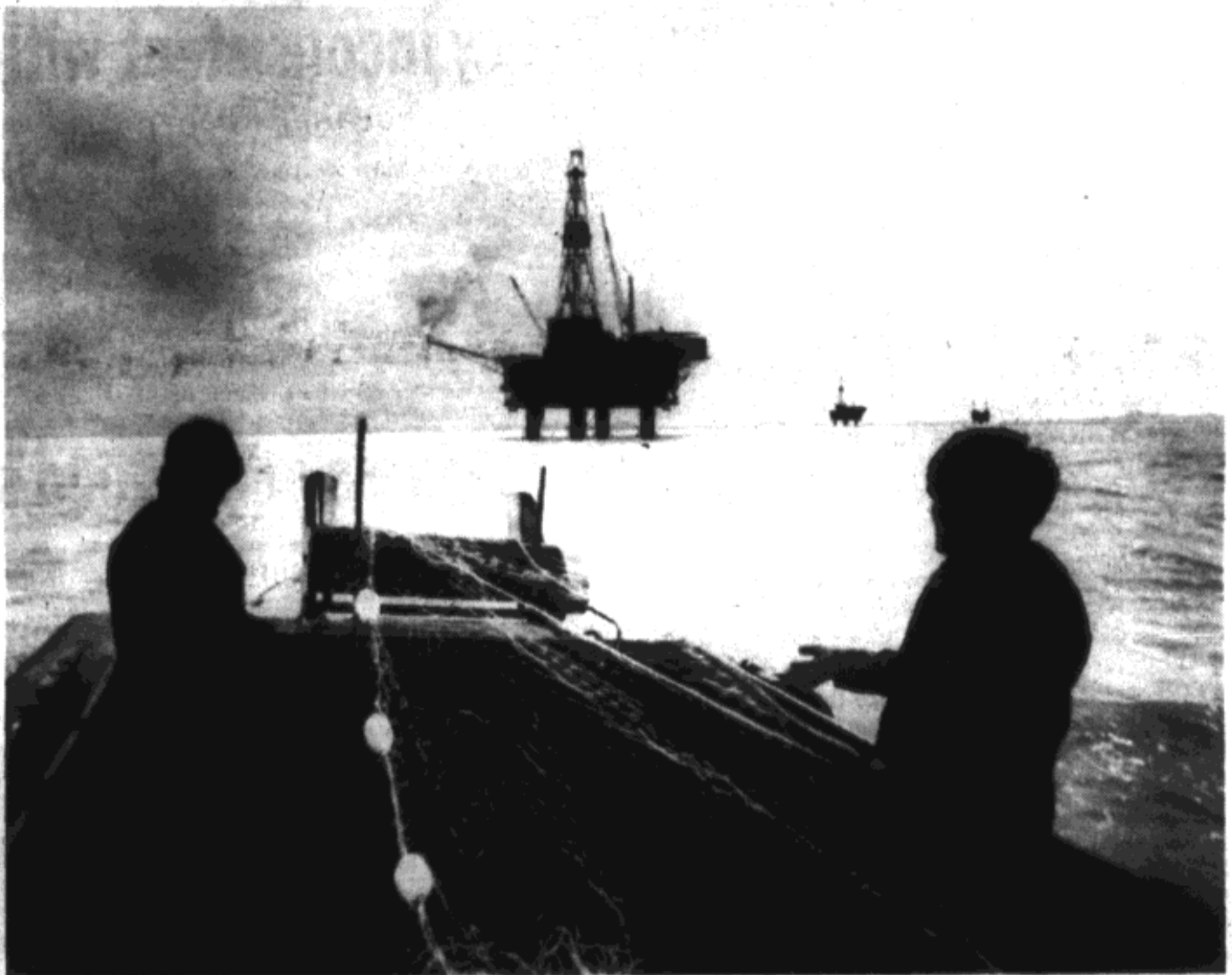
The public is invited to attend a City Council meeting in Kotzebue to discuss and comment upon the feasibility of a deepdraft port development by the City of Kotzebue. The meeting is scheduled for 5:00 p.m., Thursday, December 16, 1982 in Kotzebue's City Council Chambers.

Specific subjects of the meeting include engineering feasibility and economic considerations of a general purpose deepdraft port at Cape Blossom. The Kotzebue deepdraft port project also addresses possible airport relocation at a site adjacent to the port.

The project consulting team of Tetra Tech, Inc. and Wright Forsen Associates will present their findings to date and will receive any questions and comments.

All interested parties are encouraged to attend. This is the final public meeting scheduled as part of Kotzebue's feasibility study for deepdraft port development.
