The necessary paperwork to finalize the Cook Inlet Native Association contracts with IHS for Fiscal Year 1983 has been completed; however, due to the continuing resolution, funding for the programs is currently only available through December 17.

The Amouak Alcohol Treatment Center staff is preparing for a program review by the Municipality of Anchorage and the State Office on Alcohol and Drug Abuse which is

scheduled for early in December.

Planning efforts on the 120-unit Robert T. Rude elderly residential housing complex in Anchorage continues. The complex should be ready for occupancy late next fall or early winter, depending on the construction season. It is hoped that funding through private foundations will be approved to assist in providing medical and dental services on the site.
