Faeo cops sno-go race

KOTZEBUE – John Faeo of Anchorage travelled above the Arctic Circle to claim the championship in the Archie Fergusen, willie Goodwin Memorial Sno-go Race which is held entirely above the Arctic Circle. The race covers some 250 miles from Kotzebue - Noorvik - Selawik - Kiana - Noorvik - Kotzebue all in one day.

According to Vince Schuerch of Kiana, who sponsored several racers in the race, Faeo took home \$2,300 in prize money for his first place finish. The first place finisher in each of the three divisions took home \$1,300, second place won \$700, third paid \$500, fourth \$300, and \$150 went to each fifth place finisher. In addition to winning first place in his division. Faeo won the \$1,000 prize

for the best overall time.

There were three classes in the race: A-class 0-300 cc; B-class 300-350 cc; and C-class 350 cc and up. The A-class winner was PeeWee Stahlie of Kiana who completed the 250 miles in a time of 4 hours, 9 minutes and 49 seconds. The B-class champion was John Schaeffer Jr. the son of NANA Regional Corporation President John Sr., who finished in a time of 3 hours, 34 minutes and 40 seconds. A total of 75 racers entered the event.
