

# Video features life on Diomede

JUNEAU — The Alaska Department of Education has been given 35 copies of a video depicting life in the village of Diomede for distribution free to schools, according to the department's newsletter.

The video, "Life on Diomede as Told by the Elders," was produced by Kathy Turco through a grant from the Alaska Humanities Forum. The elder speakers are Moses Milligrock, John Iyapana Sr. and Ruth Milligrock.

The 14-minute video describes the spring walrus harvest and subsistence hunting as part of a Yupik culture and a lifestyle dependent on use of marine resources.
