

60 to Train for Electrification

The U.S. Department of Labor advised Sen. E. L. Bartlett's office this week that a 26-week retraining program for unemployed persons in designated redevelopment areas of Alaska has been approved.

It will provide training of 60 people to work on Rural Electrification Administration and Office of Economic Opportunity project for

electrification of native villages.

The Department of Health, Education, and Welfare is providing \$102,411 to fund the training project.

The Department of Labor will provide the State Employment Security Agency with funds in the amount of \$196,080 for training allowances, transportation and subsistence payments.
