

President Urges Passage of Bill; Gov. Hickel Introduces State Bill

Gov. Walter J. Hickel yesterday introduced the State land claims bill, HB 672.

"It is quite similar to the Task Force bill and it is about 17 pages long," said Rep. Willie Hensley.

He said there would be a hearing on it next Monday conducted by the House Resource Committee under the chairmanship Rep. Carl Moses. Hensley said it will go through other channels

before it gets to the Finance Committee.

"We expect difficulties there," said Hensley.

Hensley also said that President Lyndon Johnson has come out in favor of the native claims bill and urged its passage during the current session of Congress. He said Sen. Robert F. Kennedy also come out in favor of it.
