hire includes a description of the procedures for hiring, training and promotion of minorities and women by Alyeska. The plan establishes equal opportunity opportunity goals and timetables as required by law.

The revised plan for minority

businesses includes a goal to provide \$150 million in contracts and purchase orders to minority firms. This goal is an increase of \$35 million over the \$115 million goal of the original plan.

The plan also includes a

description of the procedures by which Alyeska will provide contract information to minority firms interested in supplying material and services to the project.
