LEGAL NOTICE

NOTICE OF PROPOSED CHANGES IN THE REGULATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES

Notice is hereby given that the Division of Minerals and Energy Management, Department of Natural Resources, under authority vested by AS 38.05.020(b) and AS 38.05.145(a), proposes to amend the regulations in Title 11 of the Alaska Administrative Code as follows:

1. 11 AAC 83.160(a) is amended to provide for a minimum oil and gas lease bond of \$10,000 rather than \$5,000 prior to commencement of lease operations.
2. 11 AAC 83.160(b) is amended to reinstate language inadvertently omitted in the Register 71, October 1979 amendment to the section.
3. 11 AAC 83.160(c) is amended to provide for an increase in the statewide oil and gas lease bond requirement from \$100,000 to \$500,000, and to clarify the commissioner's authority to require unusual risk bonds.

Notice is also given that any person may present oral or written statements or arguments relevant to the action proposed at a hearing to be held in the conference room of the Division of Minerals and Energy Management, 703 West Northern Lights Boulevard, Anchorage, Alaska, at 8:30 a.m. on April 22, 1980.

A copy of the proposed amendment may be obtained at the Division of Minerals and Energy Management, 703 West Northern Lights Boulevard, Anchorage, Alaska 99503.

The Division of Minerals and Energy Management, Department of Natural Resources, upon its own motion or at the instance of any interested person, may adopt, at or following the hearing, the proposals substantially as described above, or may repeal or amend existing regulations in Title 11, Alaska Administrative Code, without further notice, to enforce, administer, or otherwise implement AS 38.05.020(b) and 38.05.145(a), or may decide to take no action at all.
