Scholarships available

Two health professions scholarship programs operated by the Indian Health Service, Depart-ment of Health, Education and Welfare, under authority of Indian Health Care Improvement Act (Public Law 94-437) and the Public Health Service Act are now available in the First '80 Cycle to applicants. The Health Professions Preparatory Scholarship Program for Indians (Section 103) provides scholarship support to Indian and Alaska Native people for up to two academic years of compensatory preprofessional education to enable a student to be eligible to enroll or reenroll in a school of health professions. Section 104 of this program provides scholarship support for students enrolled or accepted for enrollment in health professions school.
