The BE Program in these villages consists of 14 Trainee-Instructors sponsored by Denak Corporation and employed under Title II. These Trainees are contact persons in the villages for Sister Jeannette LaRose, ABE-GED field Coordinator. The program runs for five months every year with people ages 18 to 81 involved in upgrading themselves starting at any grade and moving on at their own speed.

Two workshops are held with-

in the five months for the Trainee-Instructors. The last one was held in Huslia with Anna Frank as Guest Speaker on Human Effectiveness, Father Rene Astruc, S.J. on Land Claims and Leadership, and Gretchen Bersch doing Math games with the whole village while Bob Fox spoke on Banking.
