

Crafts Board To Take Calls

It may assist Indian and Eskimo artists, craftsmen, performers and organizations to know that as a special information service, the Indian Arts and Crafts Board accepts "collect" telephone calls from Indian and Eskimo artists, craftsmen, performers, and organizations who want to contact the Board's professional staff in Washington, D.C., for advice and assistance.

As an advisory and information agency, the Board encourages and promotes the development of Native American arts and crafts, and seeks to innovate in the interpretation and preservation of these arts, to foster cultural education, and to stimulate support for Native American culture.

Through this service for Native American people, the Board will pay the long distance charge for the telephone call to Washington, D.C. To contact the Board you should call between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. Eastern time, and tell your local telephone operator that you want to make a Collect Call to: Area Code 202 343-3067.
