

## Are you working in one of the following trades?

## PLUMBING HYDRONIC HEATING HVAC REFRIGERATION FIRE PROTECTION SYSTEMS MECHANICAL SYSTEM CONTROLS

If you are working in one of these trades you may need to be licensed or supervised by someone who is licensed as a mechanical administrator under legislation passed in 1988. If you were supervising or managing work in one of these trades during the two years before June 9, 1989, or if you have held related state or municipal licenses during that period, you may qualify for a license without examination under "grandfather" rights. To be considered for grandfathering you must submit either an application form, a letter of intent to apply, or the form provided below to the Division of Occupational Licensing postmarked no later than

July 1, 1989. Upon receipt of your correspondence we will send you a complete application and a copy of the statutes and regulations governing this new licensing function. The Board of Mechanical Examiners will approve all persons seeking licensure as a mechanical administrator if they qualify under the statutes and regulations adopted.
