2. 4AAC 06.022 is adopted requiring the establishment of local elementary and secondary schools in communities where children are available to attend school; providing for a procedure whereby communities where children are available to attend school; providing for a procedure whereby communities may request that no secondary school or only a partial secondary school; and defining "communities" and what constitutes a child available to attend school,

3. 4AAC 06.024 is adopted establishing standards for small secondary school; specifying the contents of the plan of service; and defining small secondary schools and defining small secondary schools and the secondary school age children.
