

4% less workers—

Wholesale and retail trade

Professional and technical workers represent less than 4% of the wholesale and retail trade, according to a booklet covering the occupational structure of trade industries, recently published by the Department of Labor.

The study, which includes the most current information since the 1970 census, is valuable to manpower planners

and education counselors, who are concerned with occupational employment in Alaska's growing trade industries.

It is used by the Department of Labor for occupational employment projections.

The information for the publication was collected through the occupational employment statistics program,

a federal-state cooperative project which generates current occupational employment estimates by industry.
