

NCA-AR meeting held at Captain Cook

The National Council on Alcoholism — Alaska Region (NCA-AR) Assembly meeting and Statewide Board of Directors meeting were recently held in the Resolution Room of the Anchorage Captain Cook Hotel.

During a presentation to the membership, Dr. Patricia O'Groman, director of prevention and education, National Council on Alcoholism, Inc. (NCA), presented NCA-AR President Ted Cordua with the NCA Bronze Key Award for his contributions to NCA-AR.

This award, which is the highest award a State Council can bestow, has only been given in Alaska on one previous occasion in 1972.
