

# Arts deadline extended

The deadline for nominations for the 1984 Governor's Awards for the Arts has been extended to Monday, Jan. 23. Nominations will be accepted until 4:30 p.m. on the 23rd at the offices of the Alaska State Council on the Arts, 619 Warehouse Ave., Suite 220, Anchorage, AK. 99501.

Nominations must be submitted in writing, and nomination forms are available from the State Arts Council. Nominations may be submitted by individuals or organizations.

The purpose of the Governor's Awards for the Arts is to recognize those individuals or organizations whose contributions to the cultural development of Alaska have had a truly significant impact upon the lives of our citizens.

Since 1967 the Governor's Awards for the Arts has been

presented to individual artists, patrons, arts advocates, organizations, schools and businesses which have helped make Alaska a state where the arts are thriving and important.

Governor's Award recipients are presented with an original work of art by an Alaskan artist, commissioned in honor of the ceremony.
