

# National health awards won

Two Alaska health organizations have been named recipients of a special new award from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, the Alaska Congressional Delegation announced.

The Alaska Neighborhood Health Center Wellness Program and the Chevron Alaska Health

Fair Project are among 35 health groups across the nation chosen from 161 nominees to receive the honor, the Secretary's Award, initiated this year.

The Wellness Program in Anchorage provides medical care to low-income Alaskans. Last year the center served approximately 12,000 patients.
