Courses at Nome, Bethel

JUNEAU-Training courses in office skills will begin in Bethel and Nome shortly, Commissioner of Labor Henry A. Benson announced.

The Bethel program will start January 18 and offer training as clerk-typists, accounting clerks and general office clerks to 15 local area residents.

It will last for 27 weeks. The project is sponsored by Bethel Social Services Incorporated.

The Nome course will begin on February 1, and continue for 26 weeks. It will offer training as clerk-typists and general office clerks to 15 Nome area residents.

Both projects are state and federally funded under the Manpower Development and Training Act and are conducted by the State Departments of Labor and Education.
