

# PEP Funded

JUNEAU — The U. S. Department of Labor has allocated \$2.6 million under the Emergency Employment Act for public employment program (PEP) jobs in Alaska through June 30, 1974, Governor William A. Egan said today.

The governor said \$1,741,000 is allocated for public service jobs and \$926,000 for "special category" hiring of minority group members and persons in area faced with unusually severe unemployment.

In addition, he said, the Greater Anchorage Area Borough is receiving \$1,322,100 in PEP funds.
