Ferry Terminal

The Department of Highways announced that it will begin advertising for bids to construct ferry terminal facilities at Metlakatla, Kake, and Hoonah, Alaska.

This work will consist of construction of approach roads and staging areas, steel transfer bridges, dolphins, and ferry docking structures.

All work at Kake and Hoonah is scheduled for completion by January 1, 1974 and by April 1, 1974 at Metlakatla.

Advertising began April 19, 1973 with bids to be opened in the Commissioner's Office in Douglas on May 10, 1973.
