

Marketing Official Dies

JUNEAU — William C. Soule, Chairman of the Alaska King Crab Marketing Board, died at Dutch Harbor.

Commissioner James W. Brooks of the Alaska Department of Fish and Game said Soule died of a heart attack while on temporary assignment replacing the superintendent of the Pan Alaska Fisheries plant at Dutch Harbor.

He had been scheduled to return to his regular duties with Pan Alaska in Kodiak.

Commissioner Brooks said that Soule was a valued member and able chairman of the board during his term of office and his loss is very much regretted.

Soule had served on the board since his appointment in Aug. 1970. He became chairman last Oct. His term would have continued until Aug. 1973.

Soule is survived by his widow, Marion, and two daughters who reside in Kodiak.
