

## Wlessing Eklutna's village theme park





Bishop Gregory of Sitka and all Alaska was in Eklutna May 12 to offer a Russian Orthodox Church ceremonial blessing of the Eklutna Village Theme Park. The last chief of the village after which the community was named, Eklutna Alex, died in 1953 at the age of 87, leaving care of St. Nicholas Church to his son Mike (Maxim) Alex.
