

# *Who is eligible for payment?*

To be eligible for payment, you must:

- Have been living on the date of the enactment of the Civil Liberties Act of Aug. 10, 1988.

- Have been relocated as a civilian by the authority of the United States from your home village on the Pribilof Islands or the Aleutian Islands west of Unimak Island to an internment camp or other temporary facility or location during World War II.

- Have been born while your natural mother was subject to such relocation.

- Have been born of Aleut descent.

You must provide your full name, including maiden name if appropriate, mailing address, date of birth, Social Security number, village relocated from, name of natural mother and her maiden name and your place of birth.
