

Students can learn about college

The Alaska Native Health Career Program is seeking junior and senior high school students who are interested in health careers to apply for the 1990 Della Keats' Summer Enrichment Program.

The 1990 program, which will be held in Anchorage, starts on June 9 and runs until July 21.

The Della Keats program offers six weeks of preparatory math, science and English for college bound

students. In addition to academic preparation, participants will receive a full orientation to the University of Alaska Anchorage campus.

Selection of student applications is already started. This will continue until 24 students have been selected.

Those students who are selected will be awarded full scholarships for the six-week program. Scholarships cover travel costs to and from Anchorage, room and board and books.
