

# Homemakers Pick Nome Woman as State Historian

Bertha Adsuna of Nome was elected to serve as State Historian for the Alaska Homemakers Council at their business meeting during the short course at the University of Alaska recently.

Bertha Adsuna will serve a two year term, and is the first Eskimo woman to be elected as a State Officer for the organization.

While attending the Homemakers Short Course at the university she she also enrolled in a class in radiological monitoring so that she might be better prepared to assist with Civil Defense activities in Nome.

Bertha was born and raised in the Golovin-White Mountain area, coming to Nome 22 years ago. This was her first trip out of Nome in that time. She is also president of the Nome Mothers Club.
