

Fairbanks Chamber On Annual Good Will Jaunt

The Fairbanks Chamber of Commerce annual Arctic Good Will Trade Trip is scheduled for today, tomorrow and Sunday, announced Dick Ward, Chairman of the Chamber's Retail Trades Committee.

"The trip is part of our continuing program to maintain fine relations with our neighbors in the Arctic," Ward said. "It also provides the additional opportunity for our business people, wholesalers as well as retailers to become better acquainted with the business people North and West of us," he added.

Plans for the trip include overnight stays at Pt. Barrow and Nome and a luncheon stop at Kotzebue. Transpor-

tation will be by Wien Air Alaska charter.

Wien has also made the necessary housing arrangements in Barrow and Nome. The flight is scheduled to leave Fairbanks this afternoon for Barrow, Saturday morning for luncheon in Kotzebue and on to Nome for dinner and the night. The return to Fairbanks will be made Sunday.

The transportation cost for the trip is \$90.00. Housing and food cost will be nominal in addition. Reservations will be accepted on a paid first come first served basis at the Chamber office.

The deadline is when the charter is full or noon today.
