

Mrs. Alaska Competition Under Way

The annual competition for the selection of a homemaker to wear the crown as Mrs. Alaska has begun. The women named to represent each community will be eligible to enter the Mrs. Alaska competition to be staged in Anchorage on April 22 or 23. The state winner and her husband will receive a 10-day expense-paid trip to California beginning April 29. At that time she will vie with representatives from all 50 states and the District of Columbia for two national honors—Mrs. America and Mrs. U.S. Savings Bonds. Total prizes will value some \$20,000 for the national winner.

Any married woman who is 21 years or older, is a citizen and permanent resident of the United States, and who has lived in Alaska one year is eligible to enter the competition. Judging will be based on homemaking ability, participation in community activities, poise, personality, character and good grooming.
