Tanning Workshops

The Cooperative Extension Service plans to hold tanning workshops in Kotzebue, Napakiak, and Fort Yukon. They are scheduled as follows: Oct. 26-31 in Kotzebue; Nov. 9-14 in Napakiak, and Nov. 16-21 in Fort Yukon.

The workshops will last all day and part of the night, according to Bill Scarborough, Extension Marketing Specialist. He and Boyd Shaffer will be conducting the classes.

The method of tanning to be taught involves using acid and salt and is aimed at bringing greater profit to those who sell tans.

A hide that brings \$5 untanned will sell for as much as \$35 tanned, Scarborough said.

Participants do not have to furnish skins for the classes but it is better if they do so, Scarborough said. Fresh hides are preferred and can be anything from squirrel to walrus. Interested persons at Kotzebue should contact Mrs. Jung.
