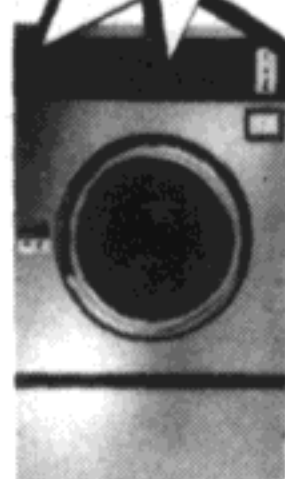

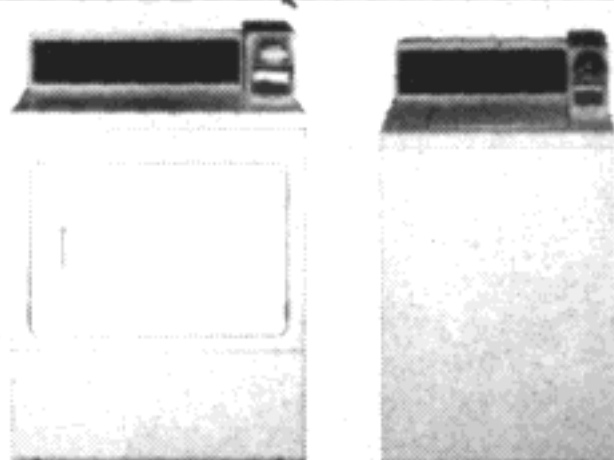

Candidates who are not selected as a Board nominee, or who do not wish to be considered for selection as a Board nominee, will be listed upon request, on the "EIA Publishing Company Management Proxy" as "other possible candidates." Biographical information about these candidates, compiled from the Nominee Information Form, is also included in EIA Publishing's proxy packet. Candidates who do not submit a Nominee Information Form may be nominated at the Annual Meeting of Shareholders but will not be listed on the "EIA Publishing Management Proxy" or have their biographical information included in the EIA Publishing Proxy packet.
