

Drug-free choice could win essay, poster contest

Alaskans for Drug Free Youth has announced their first annual statewide poster and essay contest, with the theme, "My Choice, Drug Free."

The deadline for the essay contest is Friday, and the deadline for the poster contest is April 16.

Four winners will be awarded an all-expense paid, one month summer internship in the Washington, D.C., office of either Sen. Frank Murkowski or Sen. Ted Stevens, both R-Alaska.

Graduating seniors may submit their essays on the topics "My Choice, Drug Free," typed or neatly printed on a maximum of five single-sided pages. Entries must be postmarked by 5 p.m. Friday.

Prizes for the poster contest winner include savings bonds, from \$100 to \$500, and a grand prize of a \$2,000 educational scholarship. Entries for the poster contest must be postmarked by 5 p.m. April 16.
