The monthly premium for Medicare Medical Insurance, scheduled to be increased in July, has been rolled back in keeping with President Nixon's 60-day Price-Freeze policy, according to Charles J. Brodigan, Social Security District Manager in Anchorage.

"The higher amount will continue to be charged until the premium record for each beneficiary can be corrected," Brodigan said.

"Refunds in full will be made at a later date. This also applies to Railroad Retirement Beneficiaries and Civil Service Annuitants who pay premiums for medical insurance under Medicare."
