



Kathy Eningowuk, Shismaref, wins Charles M. Soller Scholarship Award at Edgecumbe

Miss Kathy Eningowuk, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Delbert Eningowuk of Shismaref has been named the recipient of the Charles M. Soller Scholarship and will receive \$500 in financial aid to assist her in college. Kathy, who has attended Mt. Edgecumbe High School for four years was the salutatorian of her senior class.

She will be attending the University of Alaska in the fall.

This scholarship was established by the estate of Mr.

Charles M. Soller, an assistant Solicitor for the Bureau of Indian Affairs. He is credited with playing a major role in implementation of the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act. Mr. Soller died in October of last year.

The scholarship was established in accordance with Mr. Soller's wishes to recognize Native young people who have been outstanding in the areas of academic achievement and extra-curricular leadership.
