

# Tundra Times Annual Banquet in Anchorage Dec. 17

This year's Tundra Times Banquet will be held Dec. 17 in conjunction with the convention of the Alaska Federation of Natives in Anchorage, with the help of a steering committee of prom-

inent Alaskans.

The event will mark the second anniversary of the Congressional Land Claims settlement and honor Tundra Times Editor Howard Rock. Rock gave up a

promising career as an artist in 1962 to launch the Eskimo, Indian, Aleut newspaper and worked from the beginning to bring about a settlement for native lands taken by the U.S.

Government.

Serving on the banquet steering committee will be Robert Atwood, publisher of the Anchorage Daily Times; Mrs. Kay Fanning, publisher-owner of the An-

chorage Daily News; Bill Snedden, publisher of the Fairbanks Daily News-Miner; Willie Hensley, president of the Alaska Federation of Natives; George
