Aleutian Housing Authority gets funds for St. Paul homes

The Aleutian Housing Authority, serving the Aleutian/Pribilof Region, has received two program reservations totaling over \$3 million for the design and construction of twenty housing units in the City of Saint Paul, Pribilof Islands. The funds are being prowided by the U.S. Dept. of Housing and Urban Development.

The housing will consist of ten detached single family three and four bedroom homes, and seven one bedroom, and three two bedroom low-rent units.

The Alaska Housing Finance Corporation (AHPC) will contribute an additional twenty percent of the total program reservation as a supplemental housing development grant.

Actual construction of the housing is expected to begin in the spring of 1995.
