

CLERK-STENO RECRUITING

The Alaska State Employment Service is currently interviewing candidates for a proposed 12 week training course for clerk-stenographers. This course is to be financed by the Federal Government with funds from the Area Redevelopment Act. The tentative starting date, pending allocation of Federal funds, is to be June 7.

This course is designed to upgrade existing skills of persons who already have some typing and shorthand ability. To be eligible a person must be a resident of the 16th Election District, have a high school diploma, be able to type 35 words per minute, have at least 2 semesters of high school shorthand, and be unemployed.
