Sealed bids in single copy for furnishing all labor, equipment, and materials and performing all work on Project S-SG-0644(5), College Road, described herein, will be received until 2:00 p.m. prevailing time, August 29, 1968, in the Commissioner's Office, Department of Highways, Island Center Building, Douglas, Alaska.

This project consists of grading, drainage, paving, and illumination of 3.844 miles of roadway, and signalization of four intersections. The project is located in and adjacent to the City of Fairbanks, Alaska.

Principal items of work consist of the following: 186,757 cubic yards of Unclassified Excavation; 163,161 tons of Selected Material; 56,485 tons of Crushed Aggregate Base; 43,681 tons of Subbase; 18,870 tons of Hot Bituminous Pavement; 2,534 tons of Bituminous Sidewalk; 36,730 linear feet of Curb and Gutter, Type 2; 4,086 linear feet of 18" Pipe Conduit; 2,378 linear feet of 18" Wood Stave Pipe; Illumination system complete; Traffic Signal system complete; Utilities relocation and miscellaneous roadway items.

All work shall be completed by November 15, 1969.

Sealed bids in single copy for furnishing all labor, equipment, and materials and performing all work on Project F-042-1(28), 5th & 6th, L & I Streets, Signals and Lighting, described herein, will be received until 2:00 p.m. prevailing time, August 22, 1968, in the Commissioner's Office, Department of Highways, Island Center Building, Douglas, Alaska.

This project consists of the installation of traffic signals and illumination at twenty-two intersections on 5th and 6th Avenues and I and L Streets, in the city of Anchorage, Alaska, along with inter-connecting conduits and conductors.

Principal items of work consist of the following: 1 each master controller; 22 each local controllers; 234 each junction boxes; 22,433 linear feet of trenching and backfilling for conduit; 123 each traffic pole bases; 123 each poles (various types); 133,688 linear feet of cables and conductors (various sizes); 154 each signal heads; 176 each pedestrian signals; 89 each luminaries; 166 each standard signs; and miscellaneous items of associated work.
