## The Bureau of Land

Management conveyed

19.861 acres to Klawock Heenya, the village corporation for Klawock, on July 18 under terms of the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act. The subsurface estate was conveyed to Sealaska. Klawock is located on Prince of Wales Island in Southeast Alaska, one of 10 villages in the Sealaska region. To date 9 of these villages have received some portion of their land entitlement from the Bureau of Land Management.
