take the organization of the North  
Slope Borough which includes build-  
ing the property tax rolls. The  
recent oil company legal action  
against the Local Boundary Com-  
mission, State of Alaska, has caused  
difficulty in using the normal sources  
of issuing these type of notes and  
organizing the Borough.


Alaska Statutes 29.58.010.

"A municipality of the state  
which is authorized to incur in-  
debtedness may borrow money in a  
fiscal year to meet appropriations  
for that fiscal year in anticipation  
of the collection of taxes and es-  
timated revenues for the fiscal year  
and may issue its revenue anticipa-  
tion notes as evidence of the bor-  
rowing."

Alaska Statutes 29.58.050.

PRIORITY OF PAYMENT:  
"The payment of the principal  
and interest on revenue anticipation  
notes shall be payable from revenues  
and their payment additionally shall  
be secured by a pledge of the full  
faith, credit and unlimited taxing  
power of the municipality issuing  
them."
