They said they want to force the government to lay down its arms rather than the Indians laying down their arms. And they asked that those old people at Wounded Knee who may number between 30 and 40, and an engagent number of the very equivalent number of the very young be permitted out of the

young be permitted out of the area in case gunfire occurs.
When I left, things appeared very, very tense. Out at the checkpoints, there was evidence that new faces of FBI and agents were on hand. There are approximately 15 amored personnel carriers, APCs, located about 47 miles away. In addiabout 47 miles away. In addition, sorrounding the village, there are about three APC's visible. They resemble a tank. Reportedly, they do not have any armed cannon on them but they do carry 8 to 12 men who are carrying firearms.

This is the second largest Indian reservation in America. The entire atmosphere here is very electric.
