

Land Use Meeting

The joint Federal-State Land Use Planning Commission for Alaska has scheduled a four day meeting in the commission offices at 733 West Fourth Avenue, in Anchorage, March 6-9, 1973 to discuss methods of operation and scheduling for the commission's D-2 hearings to be held in April and June.

D-2 lands are those lands included in the 80 million acre withdrawal made by the Secretary of the Interior last March for possible inclusions as additions to or new units of the National Park, National Forest, Wildlife Refuge and Wild and Scenic River Systems.

The commission's 15 chair advisory committee will meet in Anchorage March 5, 1973 beginning at 8:30 to discuss and report its comments on the operation of the D-2 hearings.

All sessions are open to the public.
