

Road Projects Announced

JUNEAU Senator Willie Hensley announced that local service road projects are being planned for this coming season in the following cities and villages in the northwestern part of the state: Kotzebue, Nome, Diomedes, Koyuk, White Mountain, Pitka's Point, and Savoonga. These projects will include trail staking in various locations.

Senator Hensley was recently informed by Highways Commissioner Campbell that \$343,704 of the \$4,000,000 bond monies approved in the November election had been allocated for the western highway district.

Two construction projects have been slated for the Nome-Fairbanks Highway by the Department of Highways with preliminary engineering expected to begin in 1977 from mile 30 to 53 and from mile 53 to 69.
