JUNEAU — Nels Anderson, executive director of the Bristol Bay Native Corp., Dillingham, is the new chairman of the board of the Alaska Federation of Natives, Inc.

His election came Thursday during a board meeting of the statewide Native corporation in Juneau.

Anderson, a long-time proponent of the land claims movement and leader in the Bristol

Bay Native Association, succeeds John C. Sackett, president of Doyon, Limited, in the chairman's post.

Jack Wick, president of Koniag, Inc. Kodiak, was elected vice chairman and Andy Johnson, president of Cook Inlet Region Inc., Anchorage, was elected secretary on a unanimous ballot. Herb Smelcer of Ahtna, Inc. Copper Center, is the new treasurer.
