A training seminar on village management will be conducted by Doyon Limited March 11 through April 20 in Fairbanks.

The second to be sponsored by Doyon, the seminar will invite guest lecturers from around the state. Bill Timme is the instructor.

Any interested persons are invited to sit in on the classes,

free of charge, which will be held at a place to be announced.

Subject matter will cover land planning and technology under the village corporations setup, revenue sharing, first and second class cities incorporation and an updated analysis of the Alaska Natives Land Claims Act.

Funding for the seminar is expected to come from the Department of Community and Regional Affairs, Division of Community Planning and Research.

Approximately \$15,000 has been sought for the program, said Anderson, with the eight participants receiving food and lodging at the University of Alaska, an activity card and \$30 per week subsistence allowance.
