

Correcting errors

In the past three weeks, the Tundra Times has been referred to incorrectly in references to our position on subsistence and on the current efforts to trim the state budget.

The first incorrect reference was made by anti-subsistence activist Sam McDowell of the Izaak Walton League who quoted what he said was a Tundra Times headline which stated "Subsistence: Key to control of state land."

That headline was the page one headline in a recent issue of the Nome Nugget in an article about the controversial 35 subsistence game regulation changes.

The second incorrect reference was in a March 28 Anchorage Times story about State Rep. Al Adams of Kotzebue in which the article stated that this newspaper ran an editorial cartoon depicting Mr. Adams as a hangman and his victims as social service programs.
