- (4) instructional materials and courses offered to students;
- (5) grievance procedures;
- (6) compliance activities.

In addition to the above, the proposed regulations include actions the department will take against school districts which do not comply with either AS 14.18 or these regulations, including the withholding of State funds. Notice is also given that any person interested may present written statements or arguments relevant to the action proposed to the Commissioner of Education, Sixth Floor, State Office Bldg., Juneau, Alaska, before 4 o'clock p.m. on April 26, 1982.

This action is not expected to require an increased appropriation. Copies of the proposed regulations may be obtained by writing to: The Department of Education, Pouch F, Juneau, Alaska 99811. The State Board of Education, upon its own motion or at the instance of any interested person, may thereafter adopt the proposals substantially as described above without further notice or may decide to take no action on them.

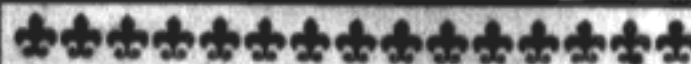
